- 2 Please find attached the Joint Commissioning Intentions for Dementia Care services in West Sussex. These have been developed collaboratively between MH commissioners at WS PCT and strategic commissioners at WSCC. The intentions represent a mix of new and exciting investment, service re-design and more strategically aligned existing provision. They have structured the plans against the 17 objectives in the National Dementia Strategy, which gives a very clear direction of travel for Dementia services. There are performance metrics at the end of the document as well to give a clear sense of how success will be measured.

These intentions have been recently approved by the Joint Commissioning Board and are now being circulated widely to all stakeholders, so that all have an opportunity to comment upon them. They do represent a work in progress and they welcome any feedback . They will be pulling together a Dementia Project Implementation Group in the autumn which will oversee the implementation of these commissioning plans.
