They would like to reach as many families as they can and ask you to please help them to promote this Fun Day to ensure a really good turn out. They are also having a further Family Fun Day on Sunday 14th June at Broadbridge Heath and of course families are welcome along to either or both.

- 4 Please see the attached details about the cookery leaders training that is being planned for delivery this year within West Sussex. This has been circulated to schools, children and family centres, and various community groups but if you think an organisation would be interested in sending someone feel free to forward this message. The uptake for this training has been quite good with between 10 and 15 people attending the 3 day course. They are also offering the food hygiene certificate on the 12th May to support the cookery leaders if they need this.  
They have had a mixture of people attending the course, nursery assistants, teaching assistants, health trainers, adventure playground staff, members of the public, youth workers, and people working with older people. They have 11 people booked on to the training in Bognor and they come from all over the county not just that area. The schools who send people on this training are then able to apply for funding through monies lodged with healthy schools to run cookery groups for parents and children. Individual updates can be sent on the schools who have delivered and who are planning to deliver sessions if this is useful to you. This is the countywide training programme and they have also been working on local projects.
