With support from John Cotcher (RDO) and myself, Vintage Radio is a station run by older people for older people and we have managed to procure a service to also allow people to listen to the Broadcasts worldwide through the internet via our website www.vintageradio.org.uk. Through lots of marketing and advertising we are hoping to have a successful project with many people tuning in, we have already received notification that people will be listening across the world as far away Georgia, America, Switzerland and New Zealand.
