- 4 LEARNING how to reduce stress will be the focus of activity at this year's annual 'Speak Out' conference for young people. Over sixty 13-18 year olds representing secondary schools from across the Horsham District will attend the day long event at Broadbridge Heath Leisure Centre near Horsham on Friday 21 November. Workshop sessions will ask participants to think about things that cause them stress, positive ways of dealing with negative emotions, developing listening skills, finding out what support is available and give participants an opportunity to say what additional support they would like. The afternoon will finish with a drumming workshop that will highlight the importance of listening and communicating in a memorable way. A full feedback report summarising the whole event and proposed actions will be prepared and circulated to all those who attend as well as to all schools and Councillors.

The Speak Out youth conference is planned by a group of young people and gives 13-18 year olds from schools across the District the opportunity to come together to learn about issues and put forward their ideas. The event, which is by invitation via each school, is organised by Horsham District Council and supported by Horsham Information Shop.
