I am the Chairman and Training Manager of the Worthing and District Amateur Radio Club. We will be running a training course for the foundation level of amateur radio on 17th January 2009 with a short examination on 28th January. Passing this exam means you can apply for an amateur radio licence, this enables you to communicate via radio anywhere in the world. You can also do much more - for example you can communicate with astronauts on the International Space Station. The cost of the course and examination is £45, this includes all the course material, refreshments and examination entry fee. The course and exam are held at Lancing Parish Hall, South Street, Lancing

The club is affiliated to the Radio Society of Great Britain (RSGB) and the examination is set by The Radio Communications Foundation on behalf of OFCOM, the Communications Regulator. All instructors are CRB checked and RSGB accredited.
