- 2 The NHS is consulting on its constitution, which establishes the principles and values for the NHS in England. The consultation ends on 17th October. All Third Sector providers supplying NHS services will be required by law to take account of this Constitution in their decisions and actions. - 4 Luna Russell, Arts Development Officer, has sent this message about the walking carnival parade through the town which will form part of this year's Horsham Town Centre Festival, led by funky samba band Barulho at 5pm on Saturday 1st November. As it is the first year they have included the parade, they are keeping it relatively small, with just a few selected community groups involved. However, they would love to have some more adults and families to join them and carry a lantern. The theme this year is 'rainbow' making it easy to dress up in a favourite colour.
Children aged 8 - 16 might like to get into the carnival spirit by attending the carnival club or lantern making workshops during half term:
 - a) Carnival Club cost £50 (LAC £25) 10.00am - 4pm from Tuesday 28 - Thursday 30 October at the Drill Hall, Denne Road, Horsham. This is a unique opportunity to learn traditional carnival skills in this three day workshop offering sessions in costume design and making, drumming and percussion music and dance. Choose your favourite to specialise in after initial tasters. A truly creative, magical time of fun culminating in the chance to show off your skills at the heart of Horsham's new carnival street parade!
 - b) Lantern Making cost £15 (LAC £7.50) 10.30am - 3pm Friday 31 October, Town Hall, Horsham. Design and make a magical lantern from willow and tissue paper which you can then carry in the parade on Saturday.
